



The Washington County Arts Council (WCAC) invites all art educators in Washington County's public and private schools, colleges, private studios, and home school programs to enter work for the February 2025 invitational exhibit. All work will be accepted.

Enter online before dropping off (see links below). Each educator can submit three works that have been completed within the last two years and not previously shown at WCAC. Artwork may be dropped off Friday, January 31, 2025 from 11am to 7pm, Saturday, February 1, 2025 from 10am to 6pm, or Tuesday, February 4, 2025 from 11am to 7pm.

The Exhibit will run from February 6, 2025 through March 4, 2025 in the galleries as well as virtually by Saturday, February 8, 2025.

All entries are to be received by WCAC no later than 5pm on Tuesday, February 4, 2025.

Liability:

Once received by WCAC, each artwork will be insured for 70% of its retail value as indicated on the gallery inventory list until it has been sold or returned to the artist.

All work must be available for sale. WCAC, a non-profit agency, retains a 30% commission on all artworks sold during the exhibit.

WCAC is not responsible for damage resulting from poor workmanship, defects, or lack of quality control by the artist.

Conditions:

If selected, hanging works should be properly prepared for the WCAC hanging system. WCAC prefers D-Hooks of sufficient size placed approximately 1/3 from the top of the work. You may alternately use eye hooks placed approximately 1/3 from the top of the work with picture wire of appropriate weight. No sawtooth hangers, please. All artworks must be labeled on the back with artist name, school, title, and price.

WCAC will not exhibit any artwork that is presented in an unprofessional manner and reserves the right of final review on all work once it has been delivered.

Work cannot be withdrawn before the end of the exhibit.

Pick Up:

All unsold work must be retrieved from WCAC between 3pm and 7pm on Tuesday, March 4, 2025.
